

Fun Facts About Paul Revere

- Paul Revere was joined by two other men riding to warn American colonists about British military activity: William Dawes and Samuel Prescott.
- 2. Paul Revere was a silversmith by trade.
- 3. He did not own a horse but was an excellent rider.
- 4. He was a member of the Sons of Liberty.
- 5. Part of his mission on the night of April 18, 1775, was to warn John Hancock and Samuel Adams that the British were planning on arresting them.
- 6. All three riders were eventually captured by British patrols, but all were released after questioning.
- 7. When the British let Paul Revere go, they kept the horse he was riding to give to a British sergeant. He had to walk back to Lexington.
- 8. Paul Revere had eight children with his first wife, Sarah, and eight more with his second wife, Rachel.
